

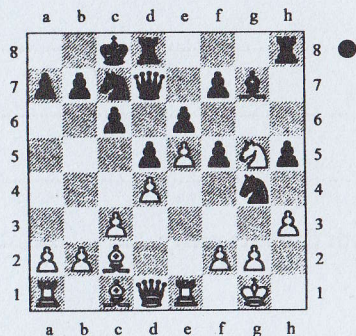

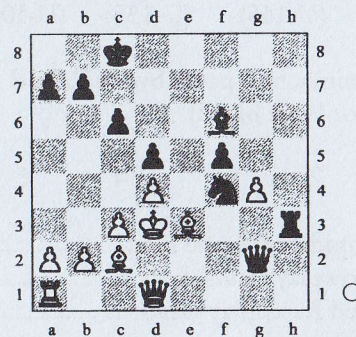

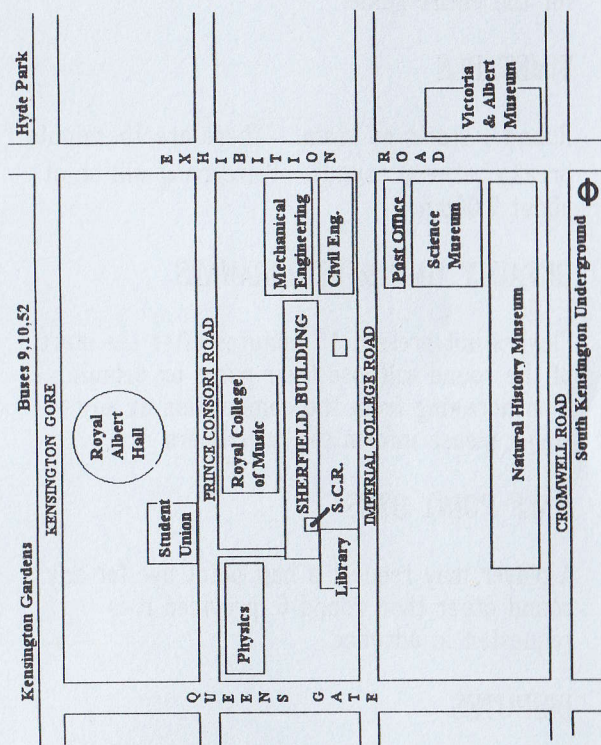

**Grading Prizes** (available only to graded players) and **Junior Prizes:** free entry to any Rapidplay.

No player may win more than one prize. Ungraded players are eligible for only 50% of the cash prizes. In the event of a tie, cash prizes will be shared, grading/junior prizes will be awarded to the lowest graded/youngest contender.

A tournament prize will also be awarded for the best attack.

## GRADING

All games will be graded. This event is registered with the BCF for Game Fee.

## FORMAT

All competitors play in all 6 Rounds. As far as possible players will be paired with others on the same score, according to Swiss Tournament Rules.

## RULES & RATE OF PLAY

FIDE Rapidplay Rules apply, and will be on display. Rate of play is 30 minutes per player for the entire game.

## TIMETABLE

Round 1 starts at 11am. There are 15-minute breaks between rounds. Prizegiving will be at about 7.00pm.

## DEFAULT TIME & WITHDRAWALS

Players not present 15 minutes after the start of the round will lose their game by default. If withdrawing from the competition at any stage, please inform the controllers.

## HALF POINT BYES

A player may request a half point bye for any round other than round 6, provided it is requested in advance.

## DISPUTES

Stop both clocks and summon the controller. The controller's decision is final in all matters.
