FREEDOM OF EXPRESSION AND STATE SEXUAL CENSORSHIP IN THE U.K.

In nearly all other European Community Member States and most other 'Free World' countries, people are free to buy and sell sexually-explicit material (often referred to as "pornography") without being subject to State censorship laws. (In France, Germany, Italy, Holland, Spain, Portugal, Denmark, Greece, U.S.A., Australia, Brazil, Czechoslovakia, Poland, Rumania, Hungary, etc.) IN THE U.K., HOWEVER, WE DO NOT HAVE THIS FREEDOM, and are still subject to the most repressive State censorship prohibitions

If you are angered by this intolerable, unique U.K. State interference in personal sexual morality and object to being dictated to by the State about what you are allowed to see, read and hear:
