Jesus has the keys of death and Hades. No longer can the enemy harm me, rage as he will. I am redeemed. Jesus is Victor!

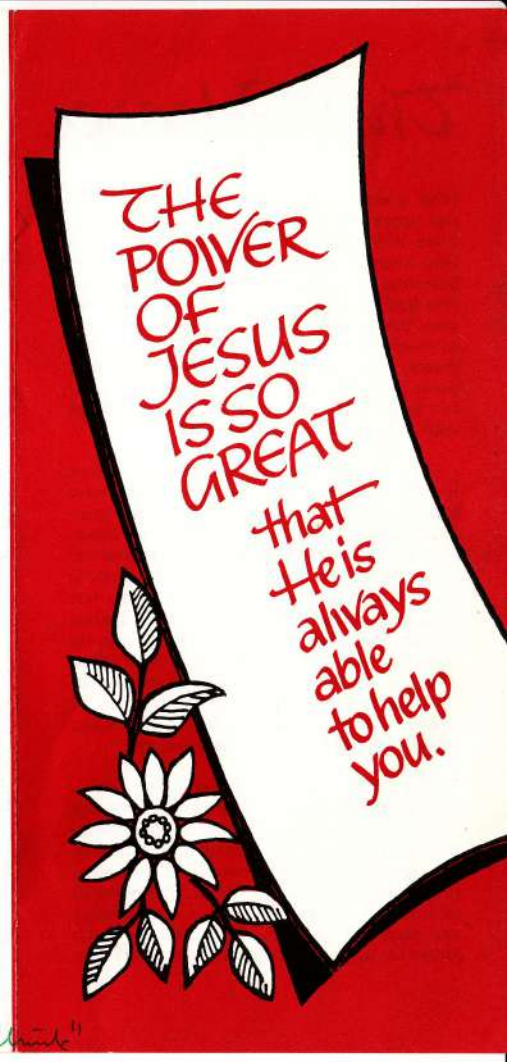

# True Release

What a wonderful ray of hope! For by getting involved with these spirits (Ephesians 6:12), you come under their power and the power of their ruler — Satan. He has no love for people; he hates them. He is the great deceiver. Jesus gave His life to save me;  
I am redeemed; He set me free!
