Eleanor was a pianist at Chethams School of Music then a singer at the Royal Northern College of Music. She has sung professionally for over 30 years for a huge variety of organisations and in a wide variety of styles from Bach to Boulez, in opera, music theatre, cabaret, contemporary ensembles and early music. As a longstanding member of the Monteverdi Choir and a member of the BBC Singers for 5 years, Eleanor has performed as a chorister and soloist at the Royal Opera House, La Scala, Carnegie Hall, Opéra Comique, the Lincoln Centre New York, Buckingham Palace and the BBC Proms as well as on hundreds of film soundtracks. As a pianist, Eleanor co-founded enSEMBLE26 in 2018 and with whom she gives regular high quality concerts in Sydenham. During the pandemic, together with her husband, Lawrence Wallington, she founded Opera That's Nice!
