

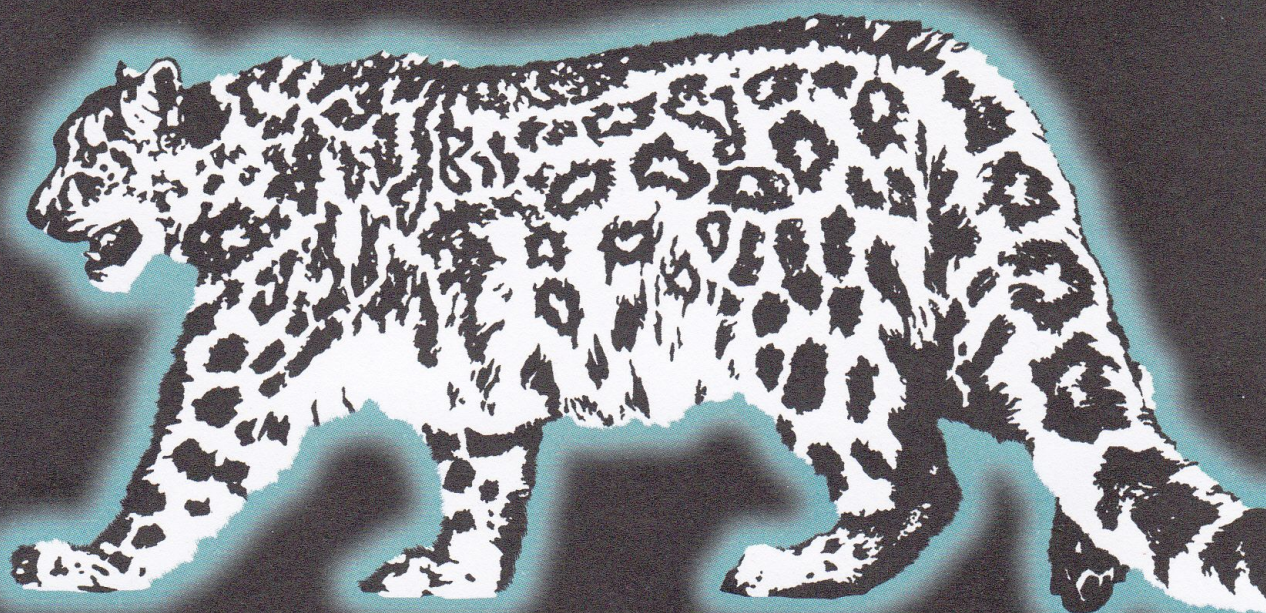

Calling all budding explorers! Come on an expedition to discover how animals and plants survive in extreme heat, cold or dryness, in permanent darkness or with little oxygen in our new, family friendly exhibition *Extremes*.

Extremes mixes games and experiments with films and stuffed animals. Visitors can get up close to some of the animals that live in these environments, try to keep up with the drinking speed of a camel, feel the air-conditioning inside an ostrich's beak, or see how much fat they have compared to a seal.

This exhibition is in three languages – English, French and Spanish.
