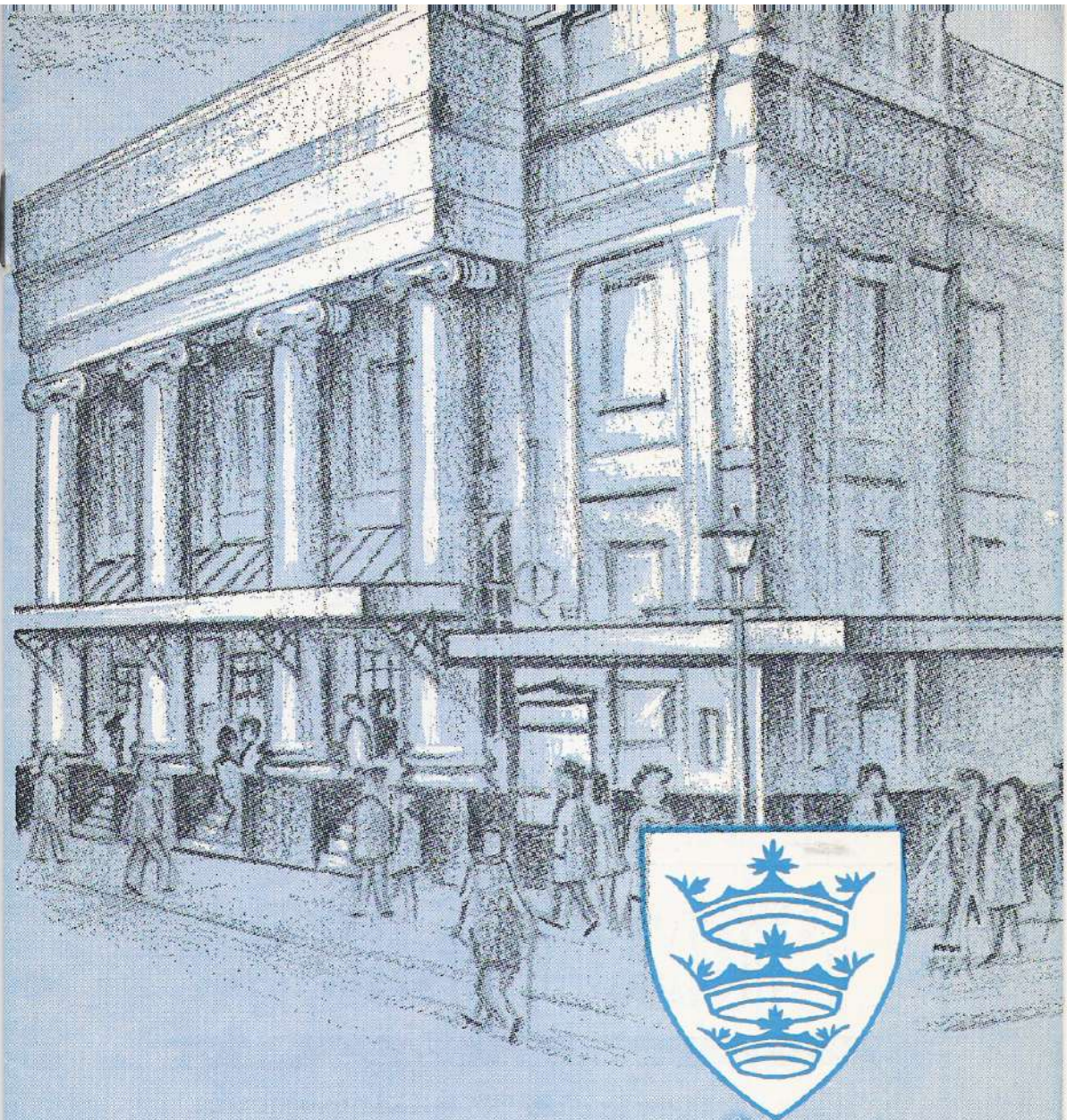

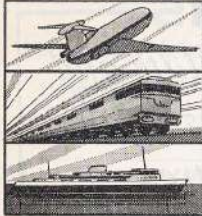

## THE CLANDESTINE MARRIAGE

by GEORGE COLMAN and DAVID GARRICK

Written by two of the great 18th Century playwrights, George Colman and David Garrick, "THE CLANDESTINE MARRIAGE" is one of the most enchanting and good natured comedies ever written, which has been delighting audiences for over 200 years.

The fat is soon in the fire and the flames are industriously fanned by Mrs. Heidelberg, the girl's aunt, who has her own snobbish ideas of high life (as well as a genius for mis-pronouncing words). Many are the misunderstandings and uproarious complications before all ends happily.

Coming to Hull with this production is a large and distinguished cast with MICHAEL DENISON, DULCIE GRAY, JOHN PAUL, JIMMY THOMPSON, MICHELE DOTRICE and AMANDA REISS. Making up the cast are BASIL LORD, PETER WILKINS, ROBERT ALDOUS, MAEVE WATT, DAVID BROWNING, MARTIN SCOTT, CHERYL VAN HOORN, WALLY THOMAS and BRIAN WESTON.
