

**THIS REGISTER**, though not an exhaustive list, includes nearly all the Hotels, Guest Houses and Boarding Houses of importance in Stratford-upon-Avon. The inclusion of an establishment in the Register does not imply recommendation, and the Corporation can accept no responsibility for complaints made against individual establishments. Justified complaints of unsatisfactory treatment will be given careful attention, however, for record purposes, and should be made, in writing, to the Information Officer. Establishments in respect of which there are material grounds for complaint will not in future be invited to apply for inclusion in the Register. Charges given in the Register are not binding, but it is hoped that they will be adhered to as far as possible.

**BOOKINGS.** Prospective visitors are urged to write direct, at the earliest possible date, to their selected Hotel or Boarding House. The Information Officer cannot normally undertake to arrange bookings during the season. Any requests of this nature which are received will be dealt with by the issue of a weekly circular, issued to selected Boarding Houses and Hotels, giving the names and addresses of applicants, and the accommodation required. If no offers of accommodation are received within 14 days of writing to the Information Officer, the probability is that accommodation is not available. On receipt of a further request, however, the Information Officer will then circulate the requirements to the remaining establishments. The fullest possible details of requirements should be given when applying. Prospective visitors are requested, as a matter of courtesy, to answer all offers of accommodation received from proprietors of Boarding Houses, &c.

It is regretted that no assistance can be given in arranging bookings unless at least 10 days' notice is given. For the assistance of visitors, however, the Information Centre in Chapel Street remains open in the early evening during the summer months, on week-days only, and maintains a record by telephone of casual vacancies in accommodation in the town.

**THE SHAKESPEARE FESTIVAL** at the Shakespeare Memorial Theatre extends in 1951 from March 24th to October 27th. The programme is issued in three parts, for each of which a charge of 2d is made, plus 1d postage. The Box Office is open from December 18th, 1950, to accept bookings for the first 14 weeks of the Festival. All enquiries for programmes and tickets should be addressed to the Box Office Manager, Shakespeare Memorial Theatre.

Accommodation for Youth Hostel members and School Parties is available at HEMINGFORD HOUSE, ALVESTON (2 miles from Stratford-upon-Avon); BROOM HALL, ALCESTER (8 miles from Stratford-upon-Avon); THE SCHOOL HOUSE, IDLCOTE, NEAR BRIMSTON (one mile from Stratford-upon-Avon, 18 beds only). Bookings should be made direct to the Warden at each address, but a leaflet of preliminary information for School Parties may be had from the Hon. REGIONAL SECRETARY (Mr. S. Newby), 46, CLAREMONT ROAD, RUGBY.

There is a CATHOLIC HOLIDAY Centre at SOLI HOUSE, MILL LANE, STRATFORD-UPON-AVON. Information as to charges and bookings may be obtained from the Warden.
