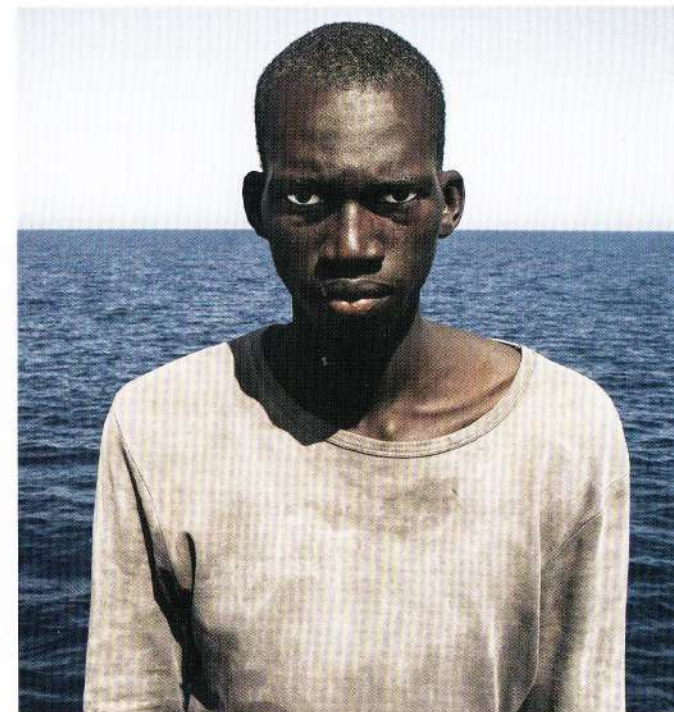
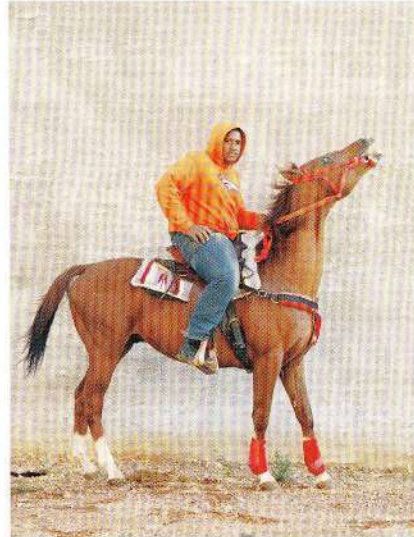

**The Taylor Wessing Photographic Portrait Prize 2017 is the leading international competition to celebrate and promote the very best in contemporary portrait photography from around the world.**

The *Prize* showcases an inspiring selection of works that explore both traditional and contemporary approaches to the photographic portrait whilst capturing a range of characters and locations. The exhibition of 59 works, selected from 5717 submissions, features all the prestigious prize winners including the winner of the £15,000 first prize.

For the third year, the exhibition features an *In Focus* display that showcases an innovative approach to portraiture by a contemporary photographer. The Gallery has selected new works by the award-winning American photographer Todd Hido.
