Parking on street.

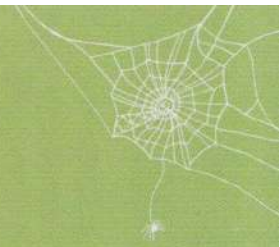
We have a toilet, shelter and refreshments are often available.
