John Colin Campbell Jordan (known as Colin Jordan) was born June 19, 1923 at Birmingham.

Colin Jordan was Britain's leading National Socialist theorist from 1956 until his death. An uncompromising defender of Adolf Hitler and a man who was proud to call himself anti-Jewish, he defended his ideology with the stoicism and bullishness of the true fanatic.

Jordan published a fair amount of material, mostly non-fiction, but also fiction of a satirical nature, which saw him dragged into court by small-minded individuals who did not share his sense of humour.

Although he picked up a number of convictions during his career, it is fair to say the only real crime that was ever pinned on him was a conviction in 1975 for shoplifting, embarrassingly at a supermarket that was founded by a Jewish businessman.

Apart from this, none of the crimes of which Jordan was convicted would have been actionable in the United States, which unlike the UK has constitutional safeguards for freedom of expression.

Jordan did not embrace Nazism until after the Second World War, and was later employed by a local authority as a teacher until his extracurricula activities made his position untenable.

Known to his friends as CJ, he was active until the end of his

life. The unrepentant Nazi passed away in the stroke unit of a Harrogate hospital on the morning of April 9, 2009.

His funeral took place at Harrogate Crematorium on April 20, 2009, Adolf Hitler's 120th birthday. His ashes were scattered amongst the trees he had planted at his home, Thorgarth.

He died without issue.
