Muriel McKay was the wife of a newspaper executive. On December 29, 1969, she was kidnapped from her South London home by brothers Arthur and Nizamodeen Hosein. They had intended to kidnap the then wife of her husband's boss, the Australian press baron Rupert Murdoch.

The Hoseins demanded a one million pound ransom which was not paid, and although they were traced and arrested in due course, no trace was ever found of Mrs McKay. On their conviction on multiple charges, they were given life sentences plus, but were paroled after only twenty years, even though neither appears ever to have revealed what happened to Mrs McKay, who is believed to have been butchered and fed to the pigs on their farm.

Muriel McKay was survived by her husband Alick, and their son and daughter.
