

Kidnap, Rape Story Fake, Woman Admits

Police say a 26-year-old Midwest City woman confessed Monday that she fabricated a story about being kidnapped and raped last week to explain her disappearance to her husband.

Midwest City police Maj. Brandon Clabes said the woman told police she stayed with two friends, a man and a woman, in an Oklahoma City motel from July 23 through July 25.

"She said she drove around all day Thursday trying to figure out what to do. Then early Friday she decided to make up this story to account for her being missing," Clabes said.

Norman police Lt. Leonard Judy said the woman had not been arrested Monday. But Judy said police will meet today with the Cleveland County district attorney's office about the possibility of charging the woman with making a bogus 911 call and falsely reporting a crime.

Clabes said Norman police found the woman in the trunk of her car about 1 a.m. Friday after receiving two anonymous telephone calls.

The woman told police after she was found that a white man and a black man had kidnapped her from a convenience store in Midwest City or Del City July 23, and had taken her to a rural farmhouse where they had raped her repeatedly over the next few days, Clabes said.

He said the woman's husband reported her missing Wednesday. Her husband said she left their home July 23 with a friend to go to an Oklahoma City nightclub and that she was last seen about 5 a.m. July 26 after she drove the friend to her home, Clabes said.

During questioning Monday, the woman told officers from Norman, Midwest City and Del City that she had called Norman police twice Friday via the 911 emergency telephone system, Clabes said. Each time she made the calls anonymously, Clabes said.

The woman first told Norman police they could find the Midwest City kidnapping victim in a Norman park, Clabes said.

He said Norman police did not find the woman so she called again and told police they could find the victim at 3000 Classen in Norman, Clabes said.

"After the second call, she went to the address, turned on her emergency blinkers and climbed into the trunk of her car. She waited for police to arrive and then pulled the trunk (lid) down," Clabes said. BIOG: NAME:
