



Jeannette Goodman – a long life well lived

Few people live to the age of 106; Jeannette Goodman did, and she lived a unique life as well as a long one. Born Marie Jeanne Schwartz into a large working class family in Northern France, Jeannette (as she was known to her friends) worked as a maid in Nazi Germany, for an eccentric American millionaire in the South of France, and an agent for the John Holt company in Nigeria, before serving as a nurse during the Second World War. She outlived two husbands and her daughter.

Edited in collaboration with her son, *RELUCTANT NURSE The Memoirs Of Marie Goodman (1915-2021)* will be published on September 9, the first anniversary of her death.
