
THE NEW SKIN TWO IS ON THE WAY

## CLUBS GROUPS

**AS** is the Swiss SM group with regular meetings at a Zürich discotheque. Club magazine (in German) with interesting addresses of SM shops. ASN, Postfach 217, CH-8600, Dübendorf.

**LONDON BISEXUAL GROUP** Pleasant and much-needed group for bisexual men and women, with support groups for married bisexuals, bisexual women only, regional groups, etc. Meetings every Monday at The Fallen Angel, 65 Graham St, London N1. Their excellent magazine, *Bi-Monthly*, covers events, politics, literature and the arts and costs £4.60 for 6 issues (cheques/POs payable to LBG) from BM Bi, London WC1N 3XX.

**SADO MASO** organise SM activities at the Palacio Del Sado in Barcelona and publish a monthly magazine (in Spanish). PO Box 12166, 08080 Barcelona.

**SADOMASOCHISTA CLUB ANDALUZ** Seville-based SM social group. PO Box 21, 41080 Sevilla.

**SM GAYS** Regular meetings for gay SM men and this is also the contact address for SM Dykes, the active and enthusiastic gay females' SM support group. BM SM Gays, London WC1N 3XX.

**SMIL** is the Scandinavian organisation producing an SM magazine (in Danish), sponsoring parties, discussion groups, etc, in Denmark and Sweden. There's an introductory leaflet in English, SMIL, Sorgenfrigade 8B, 2200 Copenhagen N (451810550 Mondays 6pm-9pm).

**CLUB SUNRISE** is a major organisation for leather, rubber, plastic, SM, and the whole fetish scene, based in Sweden. They started in 1976, and have just 300 members, holding regular parties in Gothenburg and Stockholm, producing a newsletter with a contact service. There is a section in the newsletter in English, as an EEC lingua franca. Three months' trial membership costs £16/\$20/DM.60, to Club Sunrise, PO Box 314, S-44126 Alingsas, Sweden.

**TATTOO CLUB OF GREAT BRITAIN**, run by and for enthusiasts, is the focus for tattoo fans. They produce *Tattoo International*, a monthly - subscription £15 per year (£20 overseas). Contact Lionel Titchener for information, at 389 Cowley Road, Oxford OX4 2BS (0865 716877).

**TRANSVESTITE/TRANSEXUAL SUPPORT GROUP** Advice, telephone helpline, meetings and a magazine (*The Glad Rag*) for TVs and TSs. Also useful helpline for women married to TVs and TSs. SAE with 4 first class stamps to TV/TS Support Group, 2 French Place, London E1 6JB (01 729 1466).

**VSSM** is the major Dutch group for SM people. Fortnightly meetings (see *Nightlife*), and there's even a magazine, called *Kerfstock* (42 guilders/£10 per year, or from bookshops). In this civilised country, VSSM is licensed by the local Chamber of Commerce, and regarded as a responsible group. Their aims are to provide a meeting point, and also to improve understanding about SM. There's a women's group, library and archive, even lessons in making your own equipment. It costs 96 guilders/£20 per year for one person, or 150 guilders/£35 for a couple to join VSSM. Postbox 3570, 1001 AJ Amsterdam (020-265571).
