Thank you for yr: Letter. Yr: argument is ridiculous as well as being self contradictory. The BBC is governed by its Charter & responsibility for seeing that programme content conforms with the Charter rests with the Governors as is appropriate

Since programmes are paid for out of compulsory licence fees. As I pointed out, no question of censorship or self expression arises. Whether the Governors exercise their legal powers responsibly or not is a legitimate matter for public debate. Since they appear now to have withdrawn the programme they appear to agree with my view.
