NEWS AND REVIEW

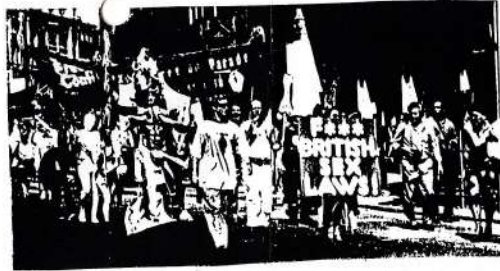
It seems a long time since the A G M but it has been a time of activity and progress .
