There is no need to dress up but erotic clothing is always appreciated - and demonstrations are especially welcomed.

A synopsis of 100 words maximum should be sent to me in advance, as soon as possible, to go on the Sexual Freedom Coalition website. The text of your entire talk (plus more if you wish) will be put on the website following the event.

There will be no TV or press cameras, and our in-house photographers will be taking photos for our website and publicity, but there is no need to be photographed if you don't want to be.

Please bring your friends and admirers - but sorry we cannot issue extra free passes, as space is very limited and we are not allowed to make a loss or we all get spanked by our treasurer, Robert.
