LEGAL REFORM

Thank you for initiating legal reform for a less intrusive society. In answer to your request for suggestions, I have drafted a Bill. It is self explanatory and I enclose a copy.

I am a lawyer and member of several legal reform societies, one of which I chair. I served as a Borough Councillor for twelve years and have been a Parliamentary Candidate. The enclosed Bill seeks to reduce State interference in the private lives of citizens.

The legal position of prostitution especially needs to be addressed. It is lawful in this country, but all activities connected with it are criminal offences. This makes prostitutes isolated and vulnerable, as the recent Bradford murders illustrate. English prostitutes' organisations appear to favour the deregulated New Zealand model, rather than the German licensed brothel system.
