3.29/4.05 GENERAL DISCUSSION points of view, questions to speakers, etc.

4.40 All three speakers make summing-up responses of 5mins' each in their original sequence.

4.55 CLOSE of meeting by Chair.

5.00 Vacate premises as agreed with management.
