These strippers are semi finalists in the Erotic Oscars. The awards are unlikely to bring them instant fame or fortune, and they may have given up a night's work to be with us. We have therefore granted them permission to collect money from guests in a jug for their performances. We're telling you this in advance, so that you PLEASE bring along change (£5 / £1 / 50p coins)

The Erotic Oscars aim to raise public appreciation of erotic endeavours and give encouragement to people working in eroticism. They are run by volunteers most of whom comprise the team of judges. The awards are fun & easy-going, rather than a serious competition. — much more chaotic and crazy than the Hollywood Oscars! Please enter into the spirit accordingly. The judges' decision is final.

The Performances will take place on and off the stage, with the strippers dancing amongst the audience, teasing as they go. Do NOT grab them or try to touch them during their act, or at any other time. No sexual services are on offer. In order that everyone can see the acts, please sit on the chairs or floor unless standing at the back of the room.

This Event is fund-raising to help cover the expenses of the Oscars, and raise money for Outsiders, a self-help group where disabled people find partners. Your ticket money is going directly to this end.

Do not leave valuables on the floor or on chairs. A cloakroom is provided for coats and bags.

The Vibe Bar is serving drinks from the bar and running the cloakroom.

No Cameras — only authorised filming and photography. If you have any worries about appearing on film, please kindly make this clear to the photographers and organisers.
