said at the launch of Prostitution Pride:

"Two thousand years of 'Western civilisation' has taken its toll of our sexuality, casting fear where there should be joy and robbing us of our power and potential.

"Sexual pleasure is not taught with reverence but treated with shame, victimisation and even criminalisation of consenting adults.

"Unlike the rest of Europe, Britain's ancient taboos are enshrined in its current mish-mash of arcane sex laws. Thanks to the cowardice of politicians, these laws have mostly remained unchanged, in the dark ages of hypocrisy breeding squalor.

"The Sexual Freedom Coalition petitions to abolish or reform them by the promotion of a Sexual Freedom Bill, to re-empower everybody for a fuller life and to flush out Britain's constipated system with sexual dignity, pleasure and peace fit for the Millennium.

"Many single, shy, lonely people and those lacking in confidence, are healed by sex workers, and it's time that society respected this important, if invisible, service."
