Thank you for your letter of the 15th enquiring about the state of NCROPA, and the enclosed copy letter from you to the Independent Television Commission. Please also write a letter to the Secretary of State for Culture about his decision to ban the "Eurotica" French satellite television station. I enclose a copy of CAC's letter to him. NCROPA has also written one. As you live in a Labour-held constituency, you should also write to your MP asking why the Labour Party believes in Tory censorship. You can use the points made in the CAC letter to the Secretary of State.

NCROPA is still active but most of the current day-to-day campaigning is being done by a new parent organisation, to which both NCROPA and CAC as well as other like-minded bodies are affiliated. It is called the Sexual Freedom Coalition. Its secretary is Tuppy Owen, who is a member of the NCROPA Executive Committee. Last year SFC presented its "Sexual Freedom Bill," which I helped draft, to the Home Secretary. Details can be obtained from SLF PO Box 4ZB London W1A 4ZB.

I am meeting Dave Webb next week to try and help him catch up with outstanding NCROPA correspondence. He is hampered by lack of secretarial assistance. We will try and have another Members' General Meeting soon. I am sad you have been unable to attend any since your move north.
