Dear Ted,

You probably won't remember me, but as an erstwhile member of NCROP - and still concerned with its aims, I thought I might drop you a line - you being amongst the forefront of the anti-censorship campaign.

It has often crossed my mind as to what extent the restriction of personal freedoms in this country is liable to go. Despite the long-time existence of the anti-censorship - or rather, pro-freedom of ressure groups, there seems to have been precious little that has improved in this direction. I was wondering, Ted, if you - being close to the ground on the matter, have any positive view or prediction as

regards the future. As a mere observer I find myself, if not filled with gloom, no real feelings of optimism. The status quo remains and shows no apparent sign of changing, as far as I can see.

I have occasionally cogitated as to why it is that Britain is so heavily censored, compared with most of the world. I have certain theories which may or may not be worthy of consideration, but I would be interested to know if you personally have knowledge of any recommendable literature on the subject. Some time ago I read a - to me - a very convincing pamphlet, influenced strongly by Wilhelm Reich, based on authoritarianism and control, which seemed to have a worthwhile argument. Have you read any of his work?
