

## Englishman Gaoled for "Blasphemous Libel" on Christ

LONDON, January 9.

The Jersey Assizes sentenced Arthur Woodhall, proprietor of the Mayfair Hotel, Jersey, to imprisonment for a month for publishing a "blasphemous libel"—namely, an impious representation of himself as Christ.

This was contained in a photograph which an aliens officer found inside Woodhall's passport showing him wearing bathing trunks and lying with extended arms on a beach with a cross inset.
