In April 1993 Searchlight magazine committed to print what will now be seen as 'a lie too far'--the assertion that a prominent anarchist, Tim Scargill, is in collusion with the neo-nazi Combat 18, encouraging them to attack anarchist bookshops and producing fake lists of BNP members. Sadly for Searchlight, we have irrefutable documentary proof that these lists came in the first place from their current star asset--Tim Hepple. This pamphlet goes into the fabrication of that smear, the reasons behind it, and reveals that the original target was the magazine Green Anarchist (GA). GA have collaborated with Larry O'Hara & Tim Scargill to write/produce this pamphlet, which also raises serious questions about Searchlights advance knowledge of C18 targetting.

It is a keynote document, containing information of vital importance to all anti-fascists, radicals, revolutionaries and Greens. The mechanisms of entrapment used by Searchlight and their secret state masters are not new--and will be/are being used against those working for radical change everywhere.
