The Luton Girls Choir was founded in 1936, and gave its **last ever performance** on November 5, 1977 as a tribute to its founder Arthur Davies who died earlier that year. The Choir was quite famous in its time; there are two or three Facebook pages dedicated to it, and many of its recordings can be found on YouTube.

One of its early members was Pamela Webb; born around 1928, she was the only sibling and older sister of the actor and anti-censorship activist David Webb, who died in 2012.
