You've probably heard of a jumble sale; a jumble trail is a new twist on it. If you live in certain areas of London, you may have seen flyers advertising them, like [this one](#). As the people behind the concept say, a jumble trail is like a car boot sale but on your street, communities co-ordinate to set up stalls outside their houses to sell bric-a-brac, toys, vintage clothes, or whatever. The whole thing is coordinated on-line at [JumbleTrail](#) providing visitors with a colour coded map to explore the treasures on sale in your neighbourhood.

So don't confuse it with a jumble sale. The concept may be new but it has been catching on in other parts of the country, including Bedford and Brighton. It is a social event as much as a street sale, complete with tea, cakes and conversation.

The brains behind the concept is a lady named Martina Randle, although she says it is probably not original. She started her first one in Clapton, London, three years ago.
