

Poker Festivals For All Pockets Coming Soon

If you are a high roller, the people at Party Poker have something for you shortly, the spring Pokerfest. Between March 29 and April 12 there will be guaranteed tournaments with a total of \$2.4 million in prize pools, 77 of them. The minimum buy-in is \$5, and for really high rollers there is one tournament with a \$1,000 buy-in. Details can currently be found on the [Party Poker Blog](#).

On Party Poker there is not a wide variety of games, most being no limit hold 'em, but this festival does feature some stud tournaments, and pot limit Omaha.

On the other hand, PokerStars features a much wider variety of games. The biggest site in the world by far, there are some very high rollers and big buy-in tournaments on this site, but it caters too for micro-stakes and indeed nano-stakes players. One of its regular

promotions is the Micromillions; the latest such event runs from March 19 to March 29. Full details of its hundred tournament schedule can currently be found [here](#). Buy-ins start from as little as \$2.20, and there are satellites! PokerStars is one of the few sites you can play stud hi-lo and razz, two games that actually have an element of skill.

If you do not have an account with either site, it is best to sign up through an affiliate like [RakeTheRake](#); this will entitle you to extra benefits, including freeroll tournaments.
