

Thailand's Asylum Crackdown

This short but eye-opening [BBC documentary](#) reveals the reason the West has a massive problem with illegal immigrants while Thailand does not. Concentrating on Pakistani Christians fleeing genuine persecution in their homeland, we see what happens to these people when they arrive in the Thai Kingdom: the lucky ones end up in squalid apartments dependent on hand-outs from charities, while the not-so-lucky ones end up in detention, and the real unlucky ones in prison with hardened criminals. The conditions of all detainees are spartan to say the least.

What does Thailand have that England for example does not? It is not what it has, rather what it does not have: white guilt, hoardes of baying left wing morons chanting about the evils of something called *racism*, and a complex process of asylum applications, seemingly endless appeals and judicial reviews, all funded by the taxpayer and encouraged by shyster lawyers.

Thailand does not recognise refugees, asylum seekers, or any other synonym for unwanted foreigners; while tourists are welcome, the doctrine of The Fourteen Words is alive and well here.

The approach of the Thai Government may seem harsh, but it is far, far more realistic than that of the West; if the UK, the EU and North America had adopted a similar approach, there would be a relatively small immigration problem instead of the imminent suicide of Western Man we are now seeing.

This does not mean nothing should be done to help people suffering genuine persecution, but what is needed is a genuinely radical approach, as **discussed here** in September last year. In the meantime: NIMBY – Not In My Back Yard.
