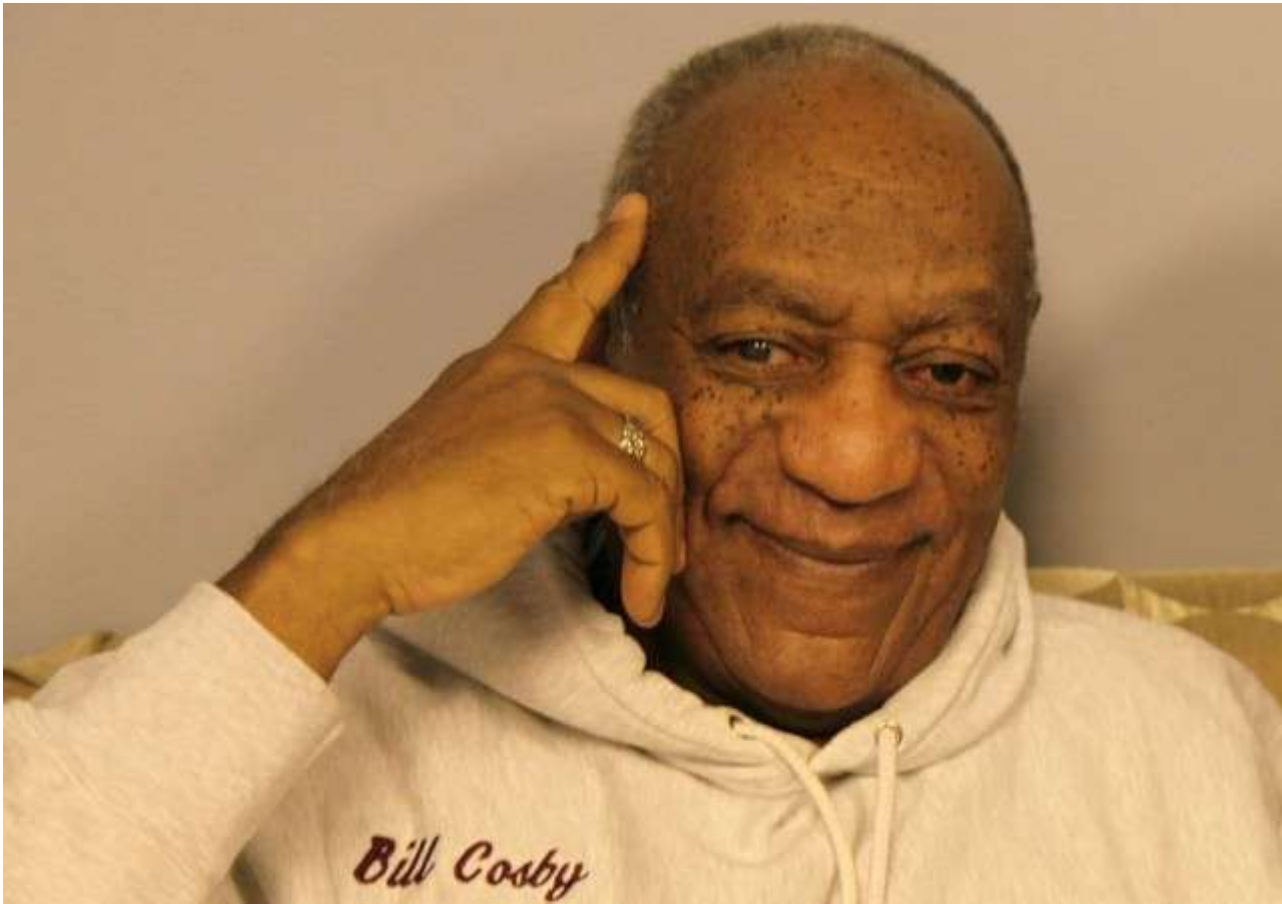


Where Are The Cosby Accusers Now?

Last October, a scandal erupted, or perhaps we should say re-erupted, after a comedian cracked a joke at the expense of another comedian. Ten years ago, Bill Cosby was accused of drugging and raping a young woman who had gone to dinner at his home. Andrea Constand, who has since returned to her native Canada, filed a civil suit when the authorities declined to press charges. News of this suit found its way into the public domain (or was leaked) and a dozen other women came forward making similar allegations.

After Cosby and Constand settled the case (apparently with a confidentiality agreement) the furore died down. Then, a decade on it returned with a vengeance, women crawled out

of the woodwork, out of the gutter, and in one or two cases out of the sewer, to accuse Cosby of everything from attempting to kiss them to serial rape. Allegations of this nature should not be made at the drop of a hat, and irresponsible reporting by the mainstream more than the alternative media was the main contributory factor in this case.



Feminist attorney Gloria Allred tried to press charges against Cosby, and has **even tried** to have the statute of limitations rescinded in cases of alleged sexual assault. She is **not the only one**. Back in January, Cosby's youngest accuser by far, Chloe Goins, was reported to be seeking to file criminal charges against the embattled comedian. As Cosby had allegedly drugged and sexually assaulted her at a party on a specific date, one attended by hundreds of people, there should have been no problem with establishing the veracity of her claim. This could have been done promptly, which begs the question why hasn't Cosby been arrested or at least asked to sit down with the police in the presence of his attorney and give his side of the story?

The truth is that allegations are easily made, especially against the rich and famous, and sometimes these allegations go viral. A few people have done their homework on this case. Back in November last year, **this article** expressed more than a little skepticism about the Cosby accusers. Others have gone further and revealed that at least one of them

communicates **telepathically with aliens**, some have almost certainly never met Cosby, and others have made allegations of a sexual nature against people before.

The bottom line is that almost all of these allegations are delusions or outright lies, women reconstructing history in their own minds as one legal analyst put it.
