WHO'S WHO

James Blair - Conductor

James studied conducting at Trinity College of Music and in Siena and Rome, winning numerous prizes. He has worked with many of the UK's major orchestras and maintains a busy international schedule. James's vitality and creativity have contributed to many memorable Chorale performances. James is Artistic Director and Principal Conductor of the Young Musicians Symphony Orchestra (see www.ymsso.org.uk), who perform regularly at St. John's, Smith Square. He has established a fine reputation for bringing rarely-heard works to the attention of concert goers.

Adam Treadaway - Assistant Conductor

Adam is a graduate of The University of York (BA Music, MA Conducting). He is highly sought after across the UK as a young and dynamic musician. He directs Take Twenty, The Foundling Museum Choir, and the Cotswold Youth Choir. He is a Vocal Animateur for the Orchestra of the Age of Enlightenment, and an Assistant Conductor with The National Youth Choirs of Great Britain and Ulster Youth Training Choir. Adam offers private instrumental tuition at Abingdon School, Oxford and Queen's College, London and continues singing engagements at Keble College, Oxford under Simon Whalley.

Janet Bishop - Rehearsal Accompanist

Janet studied at the Royal Academy of Music and regularly accompanies singers and choral groups. She is the official vocal accompanist at the Bromley, Beckenham and Blackheath music festivals and for several years was the pianist for Grim's Dyke Opera.

John Nightingale - Rehearsal Accompanist

John is a very accomplished pianist and frequently plays in local recitals and concerts, including piano quintets with the Hammig String Quartet. John is also a conductor, music editor and researcher and was for many years the Chorale's chorus master and Director of the South London Singers.

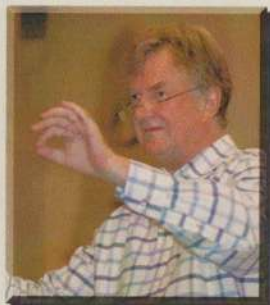


**55th Concert Season
